The Eight Cannot's

There are 8 things that an unsaved person cannot do:

He **cannot**¹ see the kingdom of God: Jn.3:3-5 *Unless a man is born again* [or born from above] *he cannot see the kingdom of God*.

He **cannot** understand the things of God: 1 Cor. 2:14 *The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned.*

He **cannot** please God: Rom. 8:8 *Those controlled by the sinful nature* **cannot** please God; and Hebrews 11:6 Without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

He **cannot** hear Christ's call: John 8:43 "You are **unable** to hear what I say."

He **cannot** accept the truth: John 14:17 *The world cannot accept [the Spirit of Truth]*, because it neither sees him nor knows him...".

He **cannot** come to Jesus: John 6:44 *No one* can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him..."

He **cannot** say Jesus Christ is Lord: 1Cor. 12:3 *No one* can say, 'Jesus is Lord,' except by the Holy Spirit"

He **cannot** believe what the Bible says: John 12:39,40 For this reason they **could not** believe, because, as Isaiah says elsewhere: 'He has blinded their eyes and deadened their hearts...'".

So, a man who is without the help of God, who is dead in trespasses and sin, and who is not saved, *cannot* see the kingdom of God, *cannot* understand the things of the Spirit, *cannot* please God, *cannot* hear Jesus' calling, *cannot* accept Jesus, *cannot* come to Jesus, *cannot* say "Jesus is Lord," and he *cannot* believe the Gospel. That is the situation he is in without Christ. That is why we emphasize the great and irresistible work of God's Holy Spirit.
